

RESOLUTION No. 2026-06

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND OUTFITTING OF A DEPUTY FIRE CHIEF COMMAND VEHICLE FROM A UTAH STATE CONTRACTED DEALERSHIP

WHEREAS, the North Tooele Fire Protection Service District (the “District”) has identified the need to purchase and outfit a command vehicle for the Deputy Fire Chief to support administrative response, emergency scene response, interagency coordination, operational oversight, and district-wide readiness; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of a Deputy Fire Chief vehicle is included on the District’s approved Capital Projects List and was adopted as part of the 2026 Approved Budget; and

WHEREAS, the total budgeted amount for the Deputy Fire Chief command vehicle in the 2026 Approved Budget is \$75,000.00, to be funded through the Capital Projects Fund; and

WHEREAS, the District Purchasing Policy provides that non-commercial vehicles (cars and pickups) shall be purchased whenever possible through State contracted dealerships and are exempt from the sealed bidding process since the State has approved the dealership annually as the low bidder; and

WHEREAS, Ken Garff West Valley Chrysler Dodge Jeep Ram is an approved vendor under Utah State Cooperative Purchasing contracts and therefore complies with District Purchasing Policy and Utah procurement requirements; and

WHEREAS, the proposed vehicle is a 2024 Ram 1500 Laramie, Bright White Clearcoat, VIN: 1C6SRFJRTBN159964 (Stock # RN159964W), with a total amount due of \$48,800.57 as reflected in the dealership purchase agreement; and

WHEREAS, additional outfitting, installation of emergency lighting, communications equipment, decals, command equipment, tools, and related vehicle modifications are necessary to place the vehicle into operational service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the North Tooele Fire District that:

1. The Board hereby approves the purchase of one (1) 2024 Ram 1500 Laramie from Ken Garff West Valley Chrysler Dodge Jeep Ram in an amount not to exceed \$48,800.57.
2. The Board further authorizes additional expenditures necessary for outfitting, installation of equipment, tools, and related modifications required to place the vehicle into operational service.
3. The total authorized expenditure for the purchase and outfitting of the Deputy Fire Chief command vehicle shall not exceed \$75,000.00, consistent with the amount approved in the 2026 Capital Projects Budget.
4. Funds for this purchase and associated outfitting shall be paid from the Capital Projects Fund.

5. The Fire Chief and Administration Chief are authorized to execute all necessary purchase documents and complete the acquisition and outfitting in accordance with District Purchasing Policy.
6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
